No. 0007561, the proposed project will construct a multi-use path along an abandoned section of the CSX Railroad bed in downtown Athens. 
P. I. No. 0007561 Athens-Clarke County Rails to Trails Project

#### **Description of Project**

The project entails the design and construction of a 14-ft wide asphalt paved multi-use trail including three bridges. The project, located in Downtown Athens, encompasses the use of an abandoned railroad bed located from the intersection with Old Winterville Road and ultimately ending on East Broad Street. The proposed multi-use trail will be approximately one mile.

The trail will begin at grade from Old Winterville Road and follow along the abandoned railroad bed to Peter Street. A single span prefabricated pedestrian bridge structure will be used to cross Peter Street and then the trail follows a short distance at grade to another single span prefabricated pedestrian bridge over Poplar Street. The existing structure crossing Trail Creek is a wooden trestle better known locally as the Murmur Trestle which begins at Poplar Street (the trestle used to cross this street). The trestle will be inspected for structural soundness and will either be utilized for the foundation for the pedestrian trail decking to traverse over, or if found unsuitable a new bridge will be required to span the roadway and creek. The trail then returns to grade for a short distance to the North Oconee River crossing. This abandoned section of the railroad contains existing piers of a bridge over the North Oconee River and Wilkerson Street. The project will include the design and construction of a pedestrian bridge utilizing the existing piers to span the North Oconee River and Wilkerson Street, then the trail will come back on grade for a short section before the end of the project at East Broad Street.

The project beginning is at the location of the proposed Athens Park and Ride Lot (near SR 10/US 78/Oconee Street and the SR 10 Loop) and ends within walking distance of the Athens Multi-Modal Transportation Center. The project also includes the construction of a tie in point for Dudley Park (near the Poplar Street crossing).
